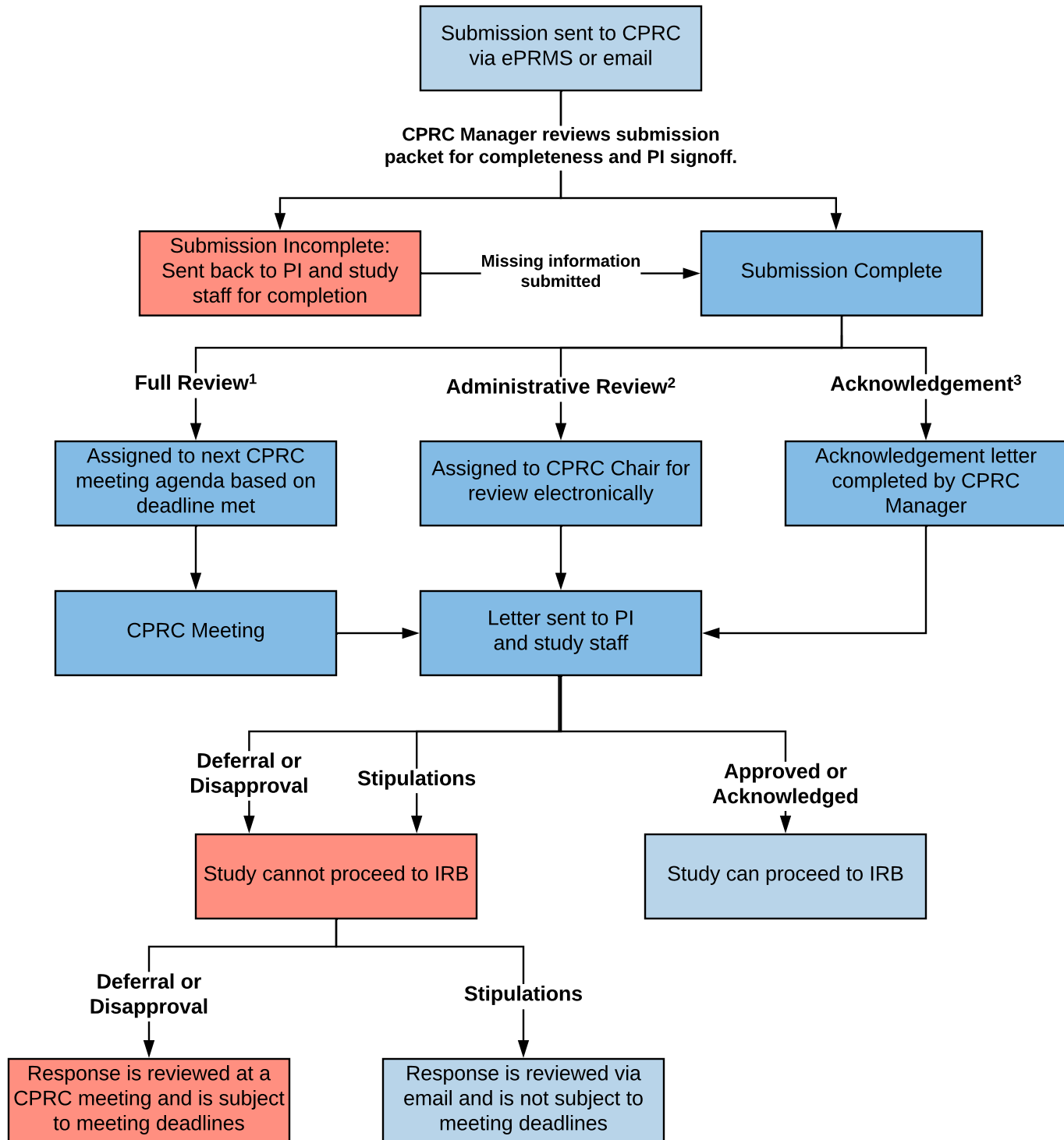


CPRC Amendment Review Process



- 1. Full Review:** Amendments involving change in scientific objectives or study design will receive full committee review. (This excludes NIH peer-reviewed studies, which fall into the Acknowledgment category below.) The IRB will not accept the submission until CPRC approval has been granted.
- 2. Administrative Review:** Amendments that do not involve change in scientific objectives or study design can be simultaneously submitted to the IRB and the CPRC
- 3. Acknowledgement:** Protocols that have been previously approved by recognized peer-review bodies and their affiliated organizations, such as National Institute of Health (NIH), National Cancer Institute (NCI), Centers for Disease Control (CDC), and the National Clinical Trials Network (NCTN).
